**Living Word will be back to in-person worship beginning  
Sunday, May 31 at 9:00 am!**

*When the day of Pentecost arrived, they were all together in one place! (Acts 2:1)*

- Seating will be in **staggered positions in family groups** (roughly six feet apart) throughout the worship center. This should allow for about **75 people**.
- **Overflow seating will be in the Crossing** with the service streamed simultaneously in order to avoid proximity issues.
- **Holy Communion** will be offered **every other Sunday** (beginning **May 31**) through a unique system that allows for less germs to be spread.
- **Bulletins will be self-serve** and the **offering plates will not be passed** but left in one place.
- Worshipers are encouraged to wear masks, but it is not required.
- **Close personal contact will be avoided**. There will be no greeting and the sharing of the peace will be verbal only (*The Lord be with you, and also with you*). Handshakes and hugs are discouraged.
- Those serving during the service will wear gloves and masks as a precaution.
- There will be **no fellowship, Sunday school or education hour** until at least fall.
- The **CDC will be avoided** altogether to prevent spread of germs with the children.
- There is a **regular sanitation process** to ensure safe surfaces prior to worship.
- Some general suggestions to be good stewards of our resources: If you are sick or high risk, stay home. If you think you may be sick, stay home. If you are unsure in any way if you should come, stay home and be safe.

Most important - **We continue to be Joyful in The Lord** as we see Him at work through this whole situation. Please be patient as the situation remains fluid. We will learn as we go while implementing these systems. Your prayers are appreciated!
