Shaking Time & Talents

SUNDAY VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES Time Commitment is about once per month and can be adapted to individual schedules. Training provided.

- Acolytes light and extinguish candles on the altar before, during and after worship services. (*Two per service*)
- Altar Guild volunteers arrive early to prepare the Lord's Supper for placement on the altar. Fill wine cups, the chalice and wafer platen. After worship, clean and store dishware. (One to two per service)
- Fellowship volunteers bring a snack, make coffee, set out beverage service, and do light kitchen cleanup after fellowship. (*Two to three per Sunday*)
- **Lectors** read pre-assigned scripture during worship service. (*One per service*)
- **Powerpoint Operators** run the Powerpoint, advancing slides in sync with the service. (*One per service*)
- Ushers prepare church prior to service, welcome people, hand out bulletins, collect offerings and direct members for Lord's Supper. (Two to three per service)

EDUCATION

Time Commitment for Sunday School teachers is every Sunday, September through May. Substitute leaders and CDC volunteers are by arrangement.

- Sunday School teachers and substitute teachers engage children PreK through high school in God's Word, using the *Answers in Genesis* curriculum.
- **CDC volunteers** read stories, help with lunch and/or crafts.
- Vacation Bible School volunteers help in a variety of ways, including leading or assisting with classes, helping with crafts or games, preparing and serving snacks, and assisting with registration, set-up and/or take-down. <u>See article page 8.</u>

Building and Maintenance *Time Commitment: Varies*

Share your expertise as a handyman or woman by helping with repair and maintenance projects throughout the year.

SPECIAL EVENTS *Time Commitment:* Varies

Volunteers help plan, set-up, take down and prepare and serve food for major events, such as the **Church Picnic** (early September) **Fall Craft Fair** (first weekend in November), **Ladies Day In** (Spring) and **Trunk or Treat** (mid-October) and other events during the year.
