


Dear Living Word Family,

I pray your summer was restful and filled with new memories. With time moving forward to fall, I found myself reflecting on the life and ministry of Moses. We will hear his final words at Rally Day worship. Moses did many things, and reading the Scriptures, it's easy to see God's hand in the midst of his life. Yet he still made plenty of terrible and selfish choices.



When he says that "If your heart turns away, and you will not hear, but are drawn away to worship other gods, and serve them, I declare to you today, that you shall surely perish," he knows it from personal experience. He knows the destruction of turning away from God and turning towards created things.

He commands the Israelites to choose life. Because God "is your life and length of days." Yes, we will sin, but we trust in the mercy and forgiveness of Christ. Moses died before he was able to enter the Promised Land. Perhaps there is a sadness there. "It's not fair he didn't get to experience what he waited decades for!" Yet, as I was reflecting on Moses, I saw the greater treasure he was able to take possession of through the grace of God. The New Creation is greater than a land flowing with milk and honey.

Part of choosing life is being connected to God's Word and His gifts. These are the places God has chosen to reveal Himself to us. Challenge yourself this year in engaging with the Living Word community and with God's Word. Be faithful in worship and receiving the Sacrament. Try out a Bible Study, either Sunday morning or one of the many offerings during the week. Explore serving the Church in volunteer ministries.

Already engaged? Invite a friend, or encourage another member to join in hearing God's Word and serving. Sometimes that single open invitation is enough to break down those barriers of "I don't know if it's my thing." No doubt Moses wanted God's people to hear God's Word and walk with Him. Even when they frustrated him, Moses still loved them! I want you all to hear the Word and receive God's gift, and I know you want the same for your friends and family. Let's pray that the Word of God goes forth and works the conversion of sinners—our own constant conversion!—this fall.
