"Now the earth was corrupt in God's sight, and the earth was filled with violence."

-Genesis 6:11

"Be still before the LORD and wait patiently for him; fret not yourself over the one who prospers in his way, over the man who carries out evil devices. Refrain from anger, and forsake wrath! Fret not yourself; it tends only to evil. For the evildoers shall be cut off, but those who wait for the LORD shall inherit the land....The wicked plots against the righteous and gnashes his teeth at him, but the Lord laughs at the wicked, for he sees that his day is coming. The wicked draw the sword and bend their bows to bring down the poor and needy, to slay those whose way is upright; their sword shall enter their own heart, and their bows shall be broken...The salvation of the righteous is from the LORD; he is their stronghold in the time of trouble. The LORD helps them and delivers them; he delivers them from the wicked and saves them, because they take refuge in him."

-Psalm 37:7-9, 12-15, 40

"Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good." -Romans 12:21

I have drawn much comfort from Psalm 37 this past month. Please read it in its entirety if you have a moment. I've highlighted some of my favorite portions of the Psalm. The heart of man is wicked continually and full of violence. Cain slays Abel. Lamech is successful by worldly measures and gloats of his murderous violence. Joseph's brothers desire to kill him. David kills Bathsheba's husband. Judas turns in Jesus to those who wish His death. Paul has Stephan stoned to death.

Death is not surprising in the world. First, we all die one day. But we also find ourselves in a culture of death. The culture has justified and celebrated the murder of tens of millions of babies over the past few decades, but this is not new. Even in the Old Testament there are many warring nations who would sacrifice babies. It's hard to find a nation in history who hasn't killed the most vulnerable among them.

While much fewer in number, ten thousand people have been "assisted in dying" in America, with the annual number growing exponentially. In Canada and the Netherlands last year, roughly 5% of all deaths were assisted. If the life ahead is full of suffering and no worldly hope, then seeking death is considered acceptable. I fear the trajectory of this practice.

What saddens me most, though, is how death has become celebrated. Death is terrible. Death is wicked. Death is the curse of sin. In the beginning, it was not so. But because of sin, wickedness reigns and the culture becomes obsessed with death. The wicked plots against the righteous, even drawing swords and bending the bow to slay the righteous!

What does the Lord do? He laughs, because He has the victory. He breaks the bow and redirects the sword. He is our stronghold. He is our salvation. Death does not have the last word. He saves us, because He is our fortress and strength. Our God is the God of life. Our God is the God of the Resurrection. As a favorite song of mine says, "[This story] can't be contained, no it won't stay in here, it will thrive; cause stories just don't die when the dead come alive." Death tried to conquer God and God laughed as He rolled the stone away from that tomb.

The wicked may have their day. But they don't have forever. Christ alone is the God of forever. And in Christ, though we die, yet shall we live. We don't repay evil with evil. Rather, we overcome it with good. Yet not our own goodness. It's the goodness of Christ and Christ alone that is our refuge and strength, and the place where we, wicked sinners though we are, have eternal life. It is the goodness of Christ that forgives sinners like me. And it's His goodness that has the power to forgive others — including our enemies and those who persecute Christ and His Church.
